DAY 1




FUEL UP FOR THE DAY

Kick off Day 1 with a coffee or cherry blossom tea from Cuatro Coffee (9014 152 St) a cozy spot where friendly baristas make every drink with care. Then discover over 30 flavours of gourmet donuts, made fresh daily on site at Gourmet Donuts & Coffee (101 - 15235 Fraser Hwy)



BLOSSOM STOP #1: SPENSER DRIVE

This is Surrey's most iconic cherry blossom street, with wide, peaceful lanes perfect for photographers, families strolling, or cycling through spring blooms. Looking to picnic? Nearby Maple Park on this street offers the perfect spot to relax or picnic amidst the serene spring beauty. (@sheila.captures)



BLOSSOM STOP #2: FLEETWOOD PARK GARDENS

If time allows, explore Fleetwood Park Gardens, home to vibrant spring displays, public art, and a scenic 1.8 km loop trail. It's a great spot for families, with playgrounds and picnic areas. (@christy_lking)



LUNCH - MAMA MOON KOREAN FOOD

It's 4.9 stars for a reason! Mom-and-pop Korean takeout spot bursting with flavour, with just a few seats. Grab your food and enjoy a picnic under the cherry blossoms or at a nearby park.



BLOSSOM STOP #3: 156B STREET

A hidden cherry blossom gem known mostly to locals, this street offers quiet, wide lanes perfect for photos and a peaceful, long stroll away from busy crowds. The blooms stretch from 156A Street to 101 Avenue. (@_anj_bart)

BLOSSOM STOP #4: 150B STREET & 24 AVE

Just a short walk (under 10 mins), this charming, quaint street is the perfect spot for morning photos. Dance under the beautiful cherry blossoms away from the crowds. When visiting, enjoy the sakuras respectfully: don't park on people's driveways, keep noise low, and don't pick the blossoms from the trees. (@somekidfromthe6)
